



Common name: Sardine or mackerel Scientific name: Sardina pilchardus

Usiform scaly body with bluish, greenish back, ventrally silvery and with a bright blue lateral line.

It has a total of 5 fins, the bifid and symmetrical flow being characteristic of blue fish.



Wandering and gregarious animal. During the day it inhabits greater depths than at night, when fishing with trawls on the surface.
